



NEW STUDENT Admissions Checklist

1st-7th Grade

- Family Tour
- Teacher Recommendation
- Principal Recommendation
- Pastor Recommendation

This is a means for St. Paul's pastors and leaders to know about the church homes of future students. Not having a church home DOES NOT disqualify a student from admission.

- Review of Recent NWEA MAP Test Scores
 - Students performing below the first quintile (1st-20th percentile) will not be allowed admission to St. Paul's.
 - Students performing in the second and bottom of the third quintile (21st-49th percentile) may be allowed admission to St. Paul's on a case-by-case basis. Additional testing at St. Paul's may be required
 - Students performing above the 50th percentile will most likely not need to be retested, unless the test was taken months ago.
- Most Recent Report Card
- Interview with the Principal
- Interview with the Teacher/Visit Day at St. Paul's

This will be held per the request of St. Paul's and/or the prospective family.
- Accommodations Plans and/or IEPs must be reported on the application for admission. Failure to do so may result in removal from St. Paul's, as student support services are limited at the school.

Kindergarten

- Family Tour
- Must be 5 by August 1st
- Must speak English fluently
- Teacher/Director Recommendation
- Pastor Recommendation

- Kindergarten screening at St. Paul's by St. Paul's teachers
- Visit Day at St. Paul's
- Accommodations Plans and/or IEPs must be reported on the application for admission. Failure to do so may result in removal from St. Paul's, as student support services are limited at the school

Preschool

- Family Tour
- Must be 3 by August 1st (three-year-old program)
- Must be 4 by August 1st (four/five-year old program)
- Must speak English fluently
- Must be completely toilet-trained
