

CONFIRMATION SPRING TIMELINE

Here is a rough outline of what to expect throughout the year. Due to Covid-19 we may need to make some adjustments as spring approaches, but this will at least help provide an idea of what to expect as you prepare for the confirmation of your child in May.

- Sunday, February 28** **Expenses Due -- \$31.00**
All students getting confirmed need to pay for their gown and flowers prior to confirmation day so we have money on hand to cover the expenses. This can be paid at any time, but by Feb. 28 at the latest. Checks can be made payable to St. Paul's Altar Guild. Please turn in all forms and money to the church office.
- Jan, Feb, March** **Family Meetings**
Each student and parents will have a scheduled meeting with Pastor Speckhard in sometime in this time frame. You'll receive information on scheduling as the time gets closer.
- Wednesday, March 31** **Preparation for Communion**
(Mandatory for those that plan to commune on Maundy Thursday)
- Thursday, April 1** **First Communion** for confirmation students (Maundy Thursday)
- Sunday, April 25** **Examination for all 8th grader confirmation students**
Meet in the sanctuary on Sunday morning for the oral exam
- Saturday, May 2**
8:30am **Pictures, Rehearsal, Brunch**
Pictures
The group picture will be taken first in the Church followed by individual pictures. Plan to wear your gown.
Confirmation Rehearsal
Rehearsal will begin right after pictures are done. Plan to end around 10:30. Bring completed banners to be hung.
Brunch
Join your Confirmation buddy for brunch to celebrate following the rehearsal, approximately 10:30.
- Sunday, May 3** **Confirmation Day**
Details concerning the time and procedures will be announced later this spring. We do ask that students follow these attire guidelines: Boys are to wear white shirts and dark ties. Dark dress shoes and socks. Girls are to wear a white or light pastel dress. No pants. White shoes.
